The wearing of **baseball caps** and 'hoodies' is not acceptable; these will be confiscated.

Black "trainer type shoes" manufactured by sports companies, e.g. Nike, Adidas, Puma, Lonsdale etc. will not be accepted as school shoes.

The Academy will be the final arbiter on what is deemed to be acceptable as school uniform.

Where a uniform infringement is identified, in order to support pupils returning to their lessons as soon as possible, parents/carers will be called. The intention being to rectify the infringement and return the pupil to lessons.

- Naming of pupil property is important for clear identification if it is misplaced or lost.
- In exceptional circumstances, where pupils are unable to wear correct school dress, parents are asked to provide a note for the form tutor to consider.
