Lincoln Talent Academy are now offering a **Pharmacy E-Placement** on their work experience system.

The E-Placement will provide students with an insight into Pharmacy through a series of videos, tutorials, quizzes and virtual tours. It will help students to develop a greater understanding of knowledge, skills and behaviours required for their chosen profession. This will assist students to make the informed choice about their future career direction.

To access these online placements, students will need to log into or sign up to the NHS Talent Academy Work Experience portal (exactly the same process as applying for physical placements) and search for 'E-Placement' or 'Placement'. Once logged in, students will need to click on the 'APPLY NOW' button. The application request will ask students for a 'START' and 'END' date, please put in today's date, this will then allow you to carry on with the process.
