Sixth form open evening – 2 November

Mr Griffiths and his team are looking forward to greeting any current Year 11 students wishing to join our sixth form in Year 12 next September. The curriculum offer we have planned is one of the widest and most far-reaching we have ever offered so we are really excited to share this in early November and support any prospective sixth form students with the application process.

We all really enjoyed meeting parents and members of the community on Tuesday on a day when the Academy was full of cakes! We were lucky enough to raise £236.53! Thanks again if you came along. It was lovely to meet you, sit and have a brew and take some valuable feedback.

Caterpod deliveries and Winners of the Caterpod design competition

We are expecting our two Caterpods to be delivered on 27 and 28 October for an immediate start after half term. Please find attached a brief menu for the two Caterpods which will be in use from after the break.

I am delighted to inform you that Brandon G in 8L/AC and Louie DR in 7T/GW won the design competition for the two pods. Toilet works and deliveries

We are about to renovate the main boys' toilets and have received a visit from the contractors this week to finalise details. With this in mind, over half term we are taking delivery of some temporary toilets whilst this work is completed. They will be placed outside in the current Year 10 zone close to the existing toilet block.

Food prices

There is much coverage in the media at the moment about food prices rocketing, as well as energy and fuel. We are not immune to these budgetary pressures. However, in response to some queries this week, I am battling to keep our food and drink prices at current levels in order that families are not inconvenienced any more than necessary. This necessitates my budget taking a huge hit in the short term in support of this plan but will continue to be my way of working until the situation is entirely untenable.

Year 11 examination guidance

We have changed the way that we deliver mock examinations for this academic year in the hope of supporting student well-being and learning about examination technique. To this end, our first set of mocks will be held in class and will be a full series of shorter mock examination papers with staff in full subject control of these. We will proceed to a full examination series in January when real examinations and mocks will be held together in the sports hall as usual. We will complete a third set of in-class mocks in March as final preparation for the 'real things'.

Year 11 revision folders, resources and interventions

In light of the above Year 11 examination announcement, Year 11 revision folders and resources will be disseminated during the first week back after half term. The timetable for intervention support will also be shared. We intend to hold a Year 11 examination assembly in the first week back.




