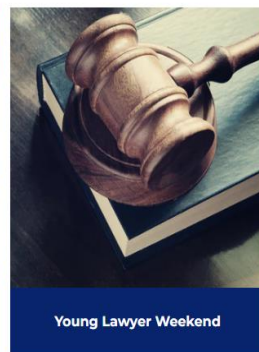

Milena R: *“Currently some of the Year 13 students are in the process of applying for universities like Oxford and Cambridge, and for courses such as Medicine, Veterinary Science and Dentistry. Others could be looking at apprenticeships that they might want to apply for in couple of months time or other courses that have a later application deadline. In terms of lower school, there was an open evening on the 20 September that had a lots of student volunteer helpers from all years, including the presence of the SSLT, and many of the parents and primary school students attended to help them make the best choice for secondary school education.”*



Careers Trip Updates

On 15 September 2023, Year 12 Geographers attended the Geographical Association Sixth Form Conference at The University of Lincoln. Fifteen schools and academies from around the East Midlands attended the event organised by the School of Geography.

During the morning, students participated in lectures about natural hazards and globalisation, gaining a real insight into what it is like to attend university and learn in a large lecture theatre experience.

In the afternoon, as part of their studies into Contemporary Urban Environments, students carried out fieldwork in Lincoln city centre to investigate if Lincoln is a Clone Town. After the data collection, data presentation and data analysis students concluded that Lincoln is moving towards being a secure Clone Town, in that it has an increasing number of chain stores and restaurants, making it much like many other cities in the UK.
