Personal Development Day 4

On Tuesday 19 March 2024, our fantastic students will be involved in a wide variety of activities to continue with their own personal development pathway this year.

Our Year 7 students will be involved in sessions focussed on puberty and 'The Warburtons Challenge', an exciting enterprise activity led by our technology team.

Year 8 will be looking at an afternoon of British Science Week activities, whilst additionally covering LGBTQ+ awareness. Our Year 9 cohort will have external speakers talking through a plethora of potential career pathways post-16 and looking at the importance of empathy.

Year 10 will have a focus on next steps too, developing their knowledge and understanding of the importance of selling themselves through a CV. They will also focus on healthy living. With revision high on the agenda with examinations approaching in term 5, Year 11 will have some focussed revision time, have further RP6th induction activities, 1-1 careers support and further fiscal education, with a look at payday loans and the dangers associated.

Students from all year groups will be focussing on Learning2Learn (L2L) sessions to reflect on how they learn effectively. British Values focussed sessions and a focus on the environment, with Green Team activities for Year 7 to Year 10 complete the lower school provision.

Our RP6th Sixth Form students are looking at driving preparation as part of their independent living skills, looking at soft skills development in team building at The Showroom and supporting with Year 11 transition to our RP6th into Year 12. Our Year 13 students will have Learning2Learn sessions and time to prioritise their final examination preparation.

We will also be awarding our first Personal Development Champions to students from all year groups who go above and beyond on the day!

Teenage Booster Vaccine Mop Up Session – Wednesday 20 March 2024

Once again, we will host the SAIS team who will visit next week to mop up any missed vaccinations from earlier in the year. You should have received the consent letter from us already.

National Careers Week

Last week was National Careers Week.

In R2L, students were asked to consider their transferrable skills in relation to their potential career, in particular, to identify those areas which they might need to develop further in order to secure their dream career.

On Tuesday we welcomed a number of ex-students into the Academy to run workshops with students from Years 9, 10 and 11 to help them consider what makes a good first impression and give their top tips for securing the career of choice. The students enjoyed meeting with the alumni and were especially keen to hear about their career paths and how they have changed from their initial aspirations.

Staff displayed their career paths on their doors, encouraging students to discuss their experiences and learn from their experiences.

This was in addition to the usual engagement with 'Job of the Week', one to one careers advice and guidance appointments and aspiration clinics.

Malicious Communication

Malicious Communications has been an ongoing problem in Lincolnshire. Online behaviour is something we talk regularly to our children and young people about with the help of online safety sessions. Parents should be made aware of these laws and the potential consequences online behaviour can have in the real world. Prevent Online Workshop

This is a free online workshop, designed specifically for parents, carers, and those who provide direct support for neurodiverse children, particularly males. The workshop contents will include:

- Understanding the specific vulnerabilities of young males with ASD or other neurological conditions which makes them particularly susceptible to radicalisation.
- Identify when a young person in your care, or who you support, is at risk of online radicalisation.
- Provide the skills and knowledge to intervene directly in an appropriate way to safeguard the young person.
- Know how to seek further support in mitigating that risk.

Workshop dates are yet to be planned but are likely to be during April/May, held online, for approximately 2 hours. Prevent would welcome any feedback on what times of day would be most suitable for these to take place.

Laws about online behaviour

There are a number of laws that apply to behaviour online.

? Is cyberbullying or trolling against the law?

Although bullying, cyberbullying or trolling are not specific criminal offences in UK law, there are criminal laws that can apply in terms of harassment or threatening behaviour. For example should you receive threatening, obscene or repeated messages and fear for your safety, this is against the law and you should contact the police. Context is taken into consideration and the police will determine the response on a case by case basis.

Some of the laws below are relevant:

Communications Act 2003: This Act covers all forms and types of public communication. With regards to comments online, it covers the sending of grossly offensive, obscene, menacing or indecent communications and any communication that causes needless anxiety or contains false accusation.

Protection from Harassment Act 1997: This Act covers any form of harassment that has occurred 'repeatedly'; in this instance, 'repeatedly' means on one or more occasions.

The Malicious Communications Act 1988: This Act covers the sending of grossly offensive or threatening letters, electronic communications or any other form of message with the intention of causing harm, distress or anxiety.

Equality Act 2010: This Act states that it is against the law to discriminate against anyone on the ground of protected characteristics. These include disability, gender reassignment (when a person undergoes a process, or part of a process – social or medical – for the purpose of reassigning their sex), race (including colour, nationality, ethnic or national origin), religion or belief, sex and sexual orientation.

Hate crimes and hate speech If you commit a crime against someone because of their religion, race, sexual orientation or disability, this is classified as a hate crime. Hate speech is defined as expressions of hatred and threats directed at a person or a group of people on account of that person's colour, race, nationality, ethnic or national origin, religion or sexual orientation. Hate crimes should be reported to **True Vision** – www.report-it.org.uk

? What other laws affect the online space?

The Computer Misuse Act 1990 says you can't impersonate or steal someone else's identity online. This means that writing a status on social media pretending to be your friend is technically against the law.

The Protection of Children Act 1978 and the Criminal Justice Act 1988 says that indecent images (naked pictures) of children under the age of 18 are illegal.

Section 33 of the Criminal Justice and Courts Act 2015 refers to the new offence dealing with Revenge Pornography. This is a law relating to images of adults (ie over 18s), making it illegal to share or make public sexually explicit images of someone else, without their consent, with the intent to cause distress.
