Year 8 National Football Cup

Yesterday, the Year 8 football team travelled to Priory Ruskin Academy in the first round of the National Cup. The Priory Ruskin team are very strong, they have several football academy players and reached the semi-final of the county cup last year. SRPA needed to be focussed and perform to their best if they were to get a result from the game, especially as we were missing two players from key positions in our goalkeeper and central defender. In wet conditions, the game was very closely contested. With few chances for either team, SRPA made the breakthrough after 30 minutes and a second quickly followed before half time. In the second half, in what was a fantastic team performance, SRPA were relentless and unwavering in their play, covering every blade of grass and challenging for every ball; they gradually began to dominate the game. Five goals followed without return, with the score ending seven-nil. This result follows an excellent start to the season having recorded convincing wins against Branston, Gainsborough Academy and Lincoln Christ Hospital School. We look forward to travelling to Wakefield in the next round of the National Cup.

Reading Survey

Our focus on embedding reading into every aspect of Academy life has continued throughout the term. Step 6: Book Appointments (Automatic)
