It aims to promote a practical understanding of policing, to encourage the spirit of adventure and good citizenship and to inspire young people to participate positively in their communities.

Cadets are supported by police officers, police staff, and adult volunteers who give their time to share their knowledge and expertise of policing and their local communities.

Cadet sessions are held on Wednesday evenings during school term times in Boston, Bourne, Lincoln, Grantham, Skegness, and Spalding.

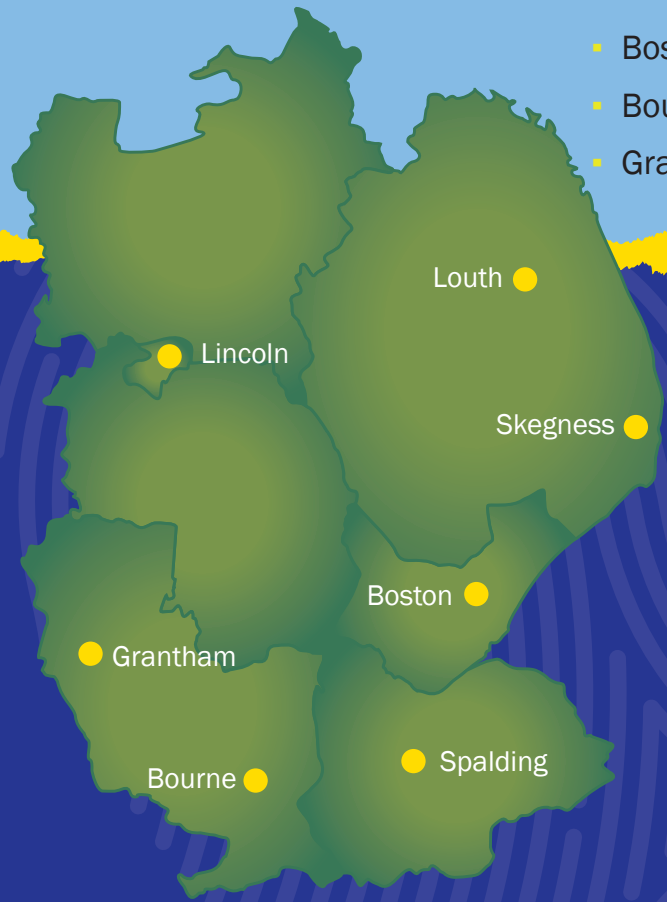
